5. Be able to attend the following:
 - Two meetings per week
 - Committee Meetings

Executive Board

Chair: Coordinates the activities of the organization, acts as liaison to University community, serves as official representative of Mustang Entertainment, presides at meetings

Co-Chair: Acts in the chair's absence and helps facilitate meetings, assists chair in coordinating activities, oversees inventory and equipment

Secretary: Maintains accurate and current information of the organization and membership, keeps accurate minutes of each meeting and forwards copies to other officers, keeps attendance records for meetings

Treasurer: Serves as liaison to WVNMU for all purpose of organizational funding, maintains accurate and current account of all organizational funds, responsible for dispensing of funds in accordance with the goals and programs established by Mustang Entertainment

Director of Public Relations (PR): Promotes events, partners with campus and off-campus media organizations, develops marketing campaigns for each major event

Scholarships: Executive Board members will receive a scholarship from ASWVNMU per semester. Executive Board members will have to meet the criteria mentioned to receive scholarship monies. Allocation of money will be pro-rated based on the amount of missed meetings. Executive Board members are required to attend two meetings per week, each week of the 16-week semester.
